# CLEARWATER RECYCLES DO MORE BLUE – SIMPLIFY TO 5

Recycling does not have to be difficult. Simplify to 5 and recycle right. Include only the following:

- 1. Plastic bottles and containers Lids stay on
- 2. Metal cans (tin, steel, aluminum and empty aerosol cans)
- 3. Glass bottles and jars Remove lids or caps
- 4. Cardboard boxes flattened
- 5. Paper Includes junk mail, paperboard like cereal boxes, etc.

All containers should be empty, dry and unbagged items only. *When in doubt, throw it out!* 

### Do Not Include the following in your Recycle Container:

No plastic bags, wrap or tarps

No ceramics, glassware or mirrors

No food or liquids

No yard waste

No dirty cardboard like pizza boxes

No polystyrene, foam, shredded papers, paper cups, plates, utensils

No wrapping paper

No small appliances, electronics or batteries

No plastic toys, buckets or other hard plastics

No "tanglers" such as hoses, wires, clothing or textiles

No hazardous waste such as paint, tires or propane tanks

No scrap metal, auto parts, tools, pots or pans
