All of the storm drains in the subdivision have been painted yellow. We hope this will help prevent people from hitting them as they park along the roads and turn the corners. The sign posts at the ends of Barber and Mandarin have also been painted yellow. The hedges at the end of Barber and Mandarin have been trimmed and we plan to trim the crape myrtle trees in the spring.

We are looking into repainting the fire hydrants in the neighborhood. We have to get the Fire Department's permission before this project can be completed.
